

We now have planning approval to develop the exciting plans for our new clubhouse. Funding for this is a huge issue for the club, as we have currently been unable to secure a Sport England, ECB or other form of grant.

This means that the project has to be fully funded by the club and we therefore have to raise £150,000 through our own activities and endeavours.

This is a big challenge but with support from all members, past and present, the local community and other people who wish to make a real difference, we are sure that we can achieve this.

We are planning to start the project in September 2018 and have the new facility completed for the start of the 2019 season.

The majority of the funding will come from loans, which will have to be repaid over the next 5 years.





We have a season that is 5 months long and we need to raise £5,000 per month, just, to cover these costs, before we even start developing or building for the future.
